Latrobe, PA -- Adelphoi Village has been awarded re-accreditation by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO). Adelphoi Village has been continuously accredited since 1998.

The Joint Commission evaluates and accredits more than 18,000 health care and behavioral health care organizations in the United States. It is the nation's oldest and largest standards-setting and accrediting body in health care.

Adelphoi Village is one of the few child care agencies in the state who has pursued this accreditation. The process includes an unannounced, on-site review of its compliance with national standards in addressing the safety, permanency planning, and well-being of the children and families Adelphoi serves.

“Adelphoi Village voluntarily pursued this comprehensive, independent evaluation to enhance the safety and quality of care we provide,” says Mike McCalpin, Chief Operating Officer for Adelphoi Village. “We’re proud to achieve this distinction.”
